(Bureau of Police Research and Development)

New Delhi, the 27th June, 2002

G.S.R. 254.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Bureau of Police Research and Development (Research Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Bureau of Police Research and Development (Research Officer) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2002.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. For the Schedule to the Bureau of Police Research and Development (Research Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1981, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely :—

			NOTE 2.—The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes. If at any stage of selection the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.
