

FOREWORD

"Data on Police Organisations in India" is compiled annually and presented in a book form. This contains some useful basic information in respect of the CPOs and the Police organisations of the States and Union Territories such as area, population, police strength, registered crime, police men killed on duty, police expenditure, status of housing, police training institutions etc. The data collected from all the States and Union Territories has been compiled and analysed on all India basis to show all India level cumulative figures and comparative figures amongst the States. Therefore it becomes a very useful reference for planning and development in Police Departments.

This year BPR&D had taken up an all India study of the average stay of the Superintendents of Police of districts, covering a period of five years i.e. 2000 to 2004. The data collected during this study is also given in the present volume, which the readers may find useful.

Collection of a large volume of reliable data under various heads is always a daunting task. However, with the active cooperation received by us from the Heads of CPOs, Directors General / Inspectors General of Police of the States/UTs, Director, NCRB and others, we have succeeded in producing this volume. There are, however, some inconsistencies in the data supplied by the State/UT Police establishments, we hope the concerned Police establishments will look into them and take steps to ensure accuracy of data for the next volume. Still we hope that it would be a useful aid to the managers of the police organizations and the researchers.

Appreciation is due to Shri R.C. Arora, Director (R&D), BPR&D, who envisioned this enlargement and worked tirelessly to translate it into reality. He was ably assisted by S/Shri S. N. Gupta, A. H. Ramteke, K. K. Meena and Smt. Uma Negi, officers of statistical section of the BPR&D, in this endeavour. We owe them a debt of gratitude.

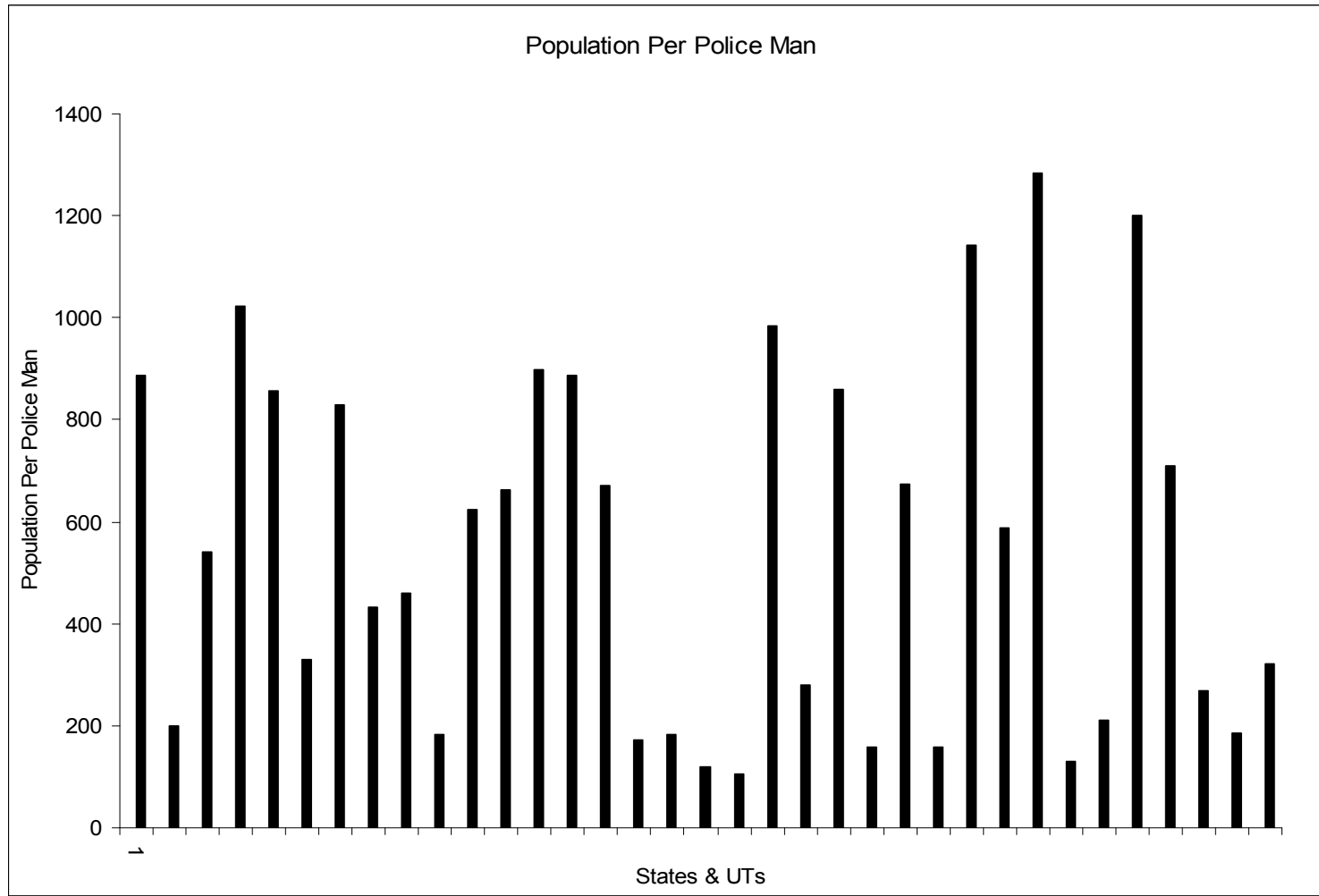

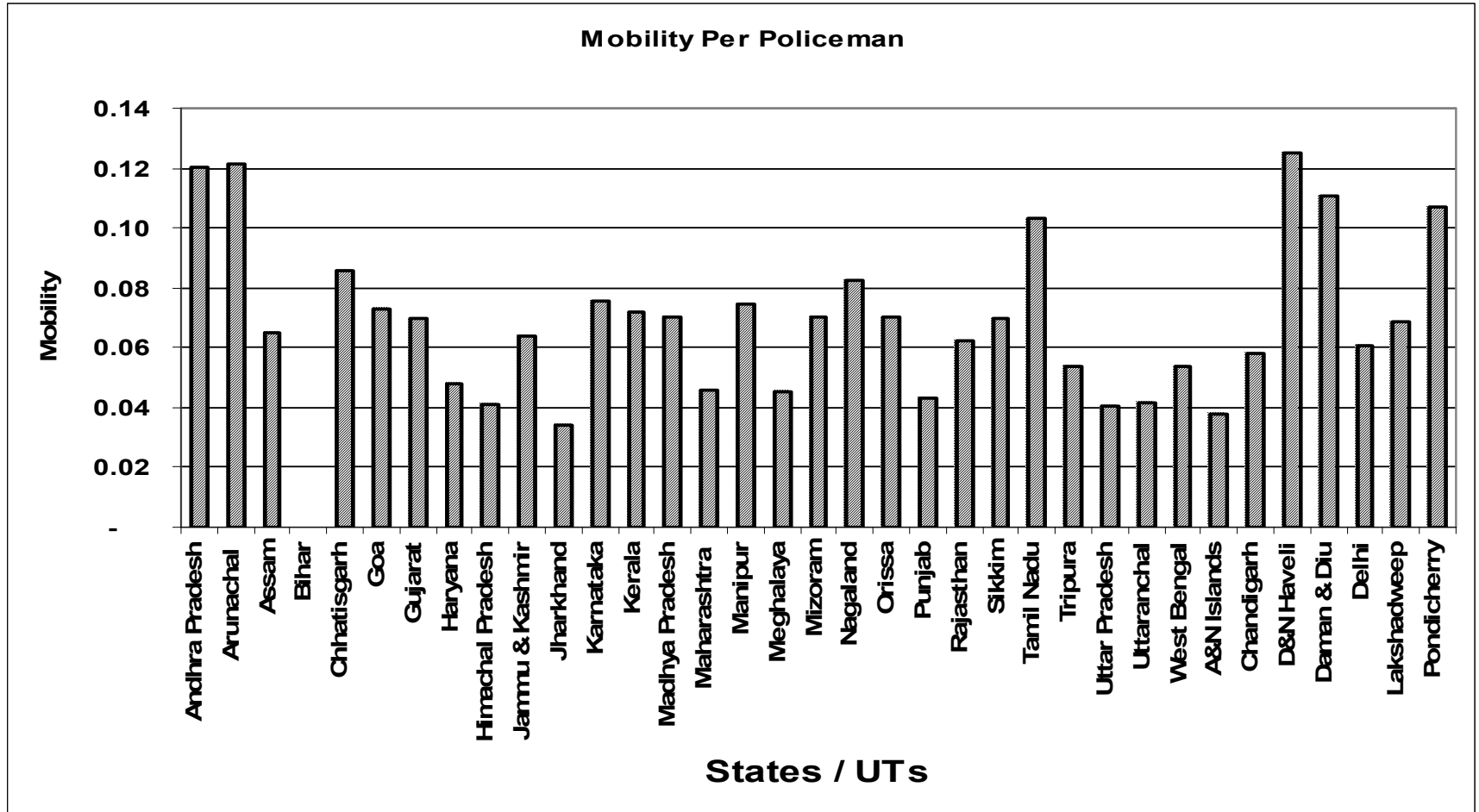

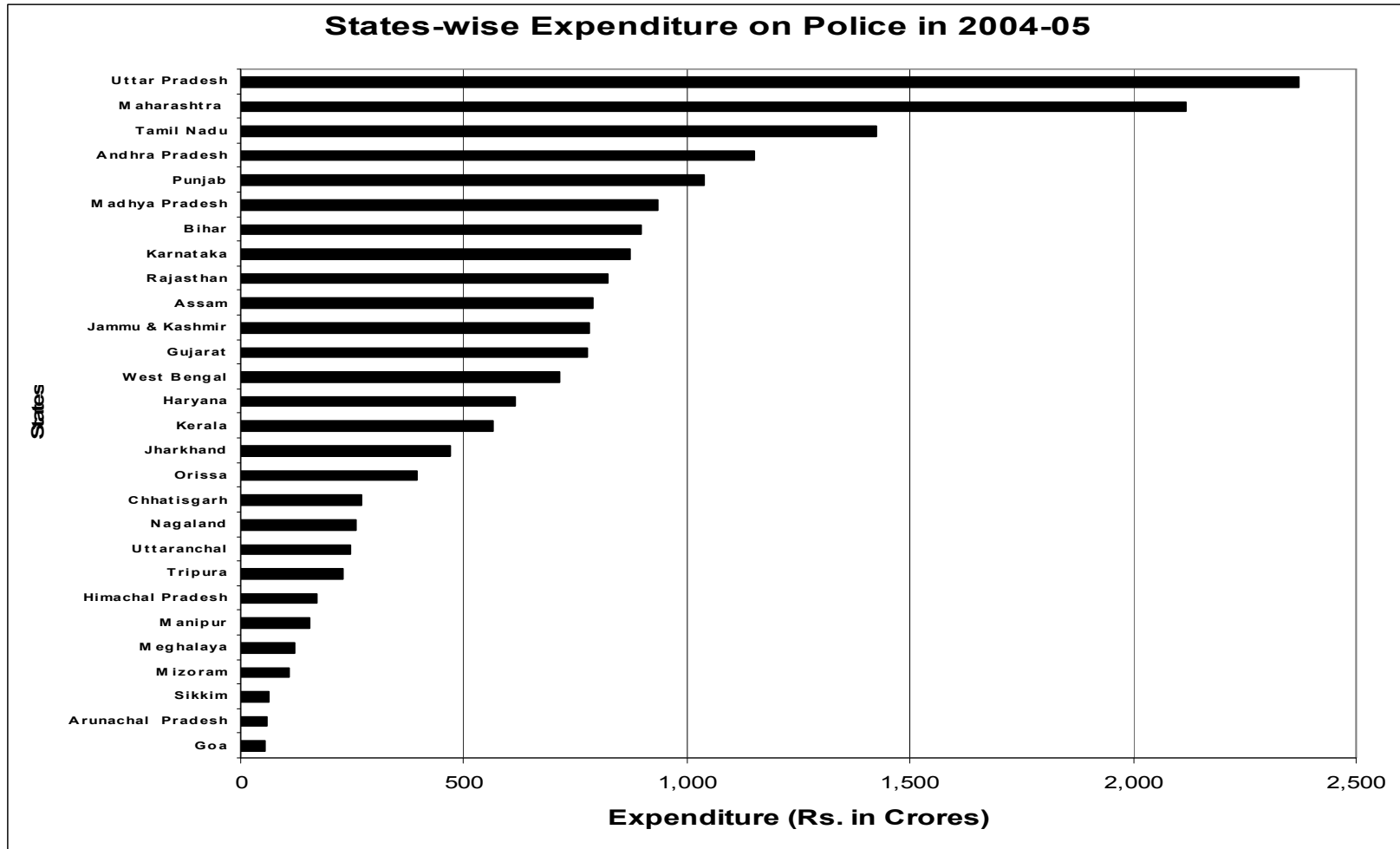

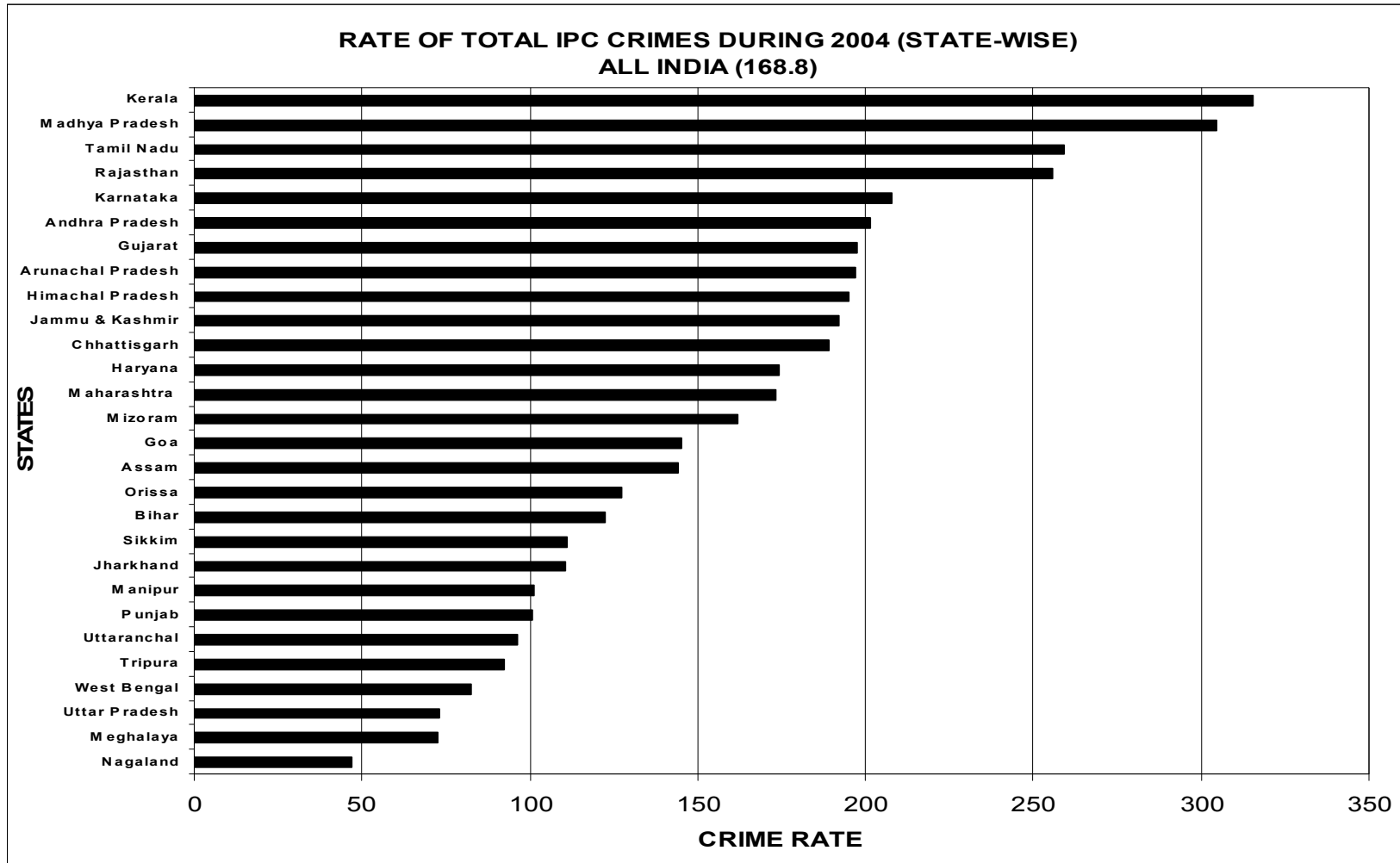

PERCENTAGE CONTRIBUTION OF IPC CRIMES TO TOTAL CRIMES DURING 2004

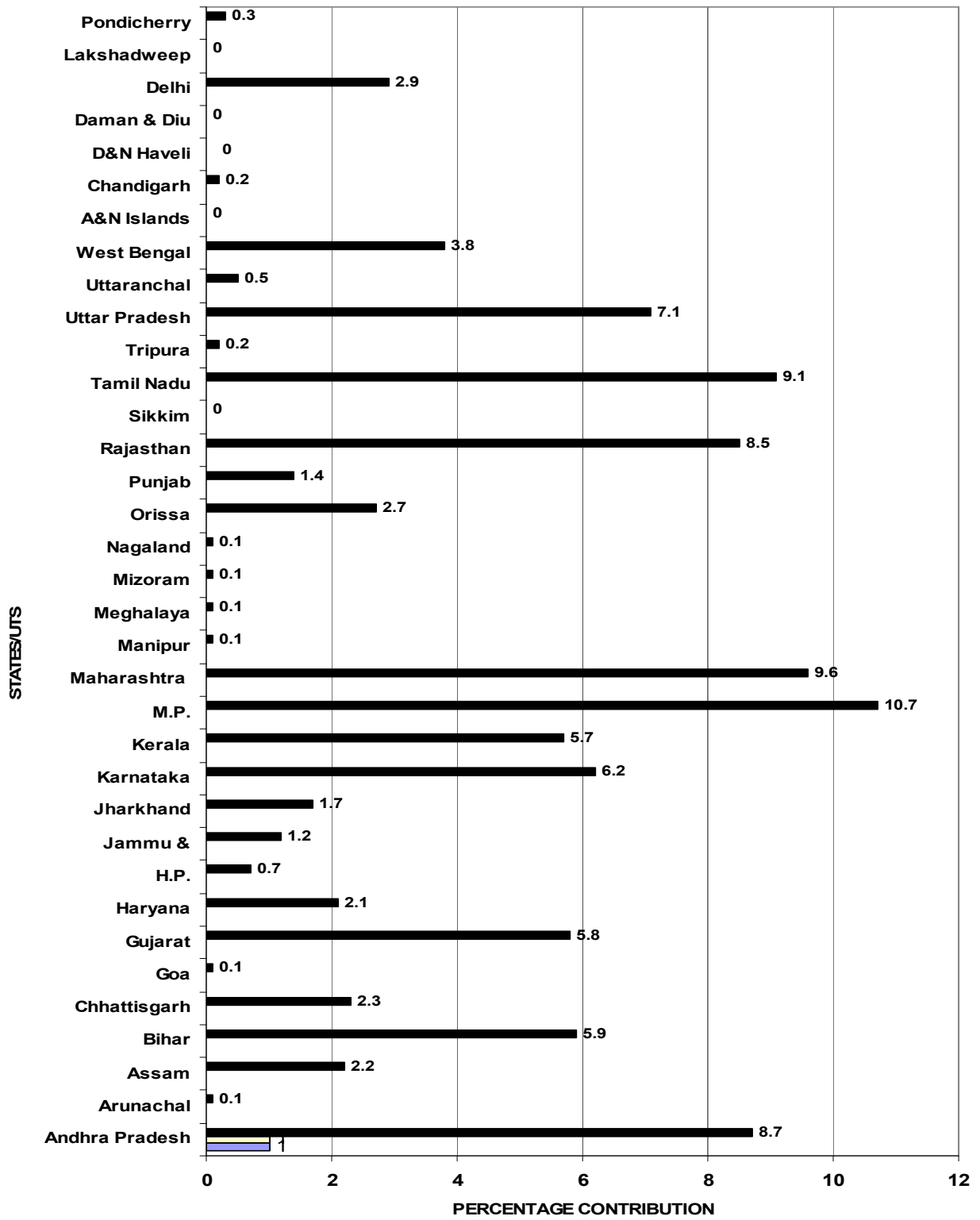

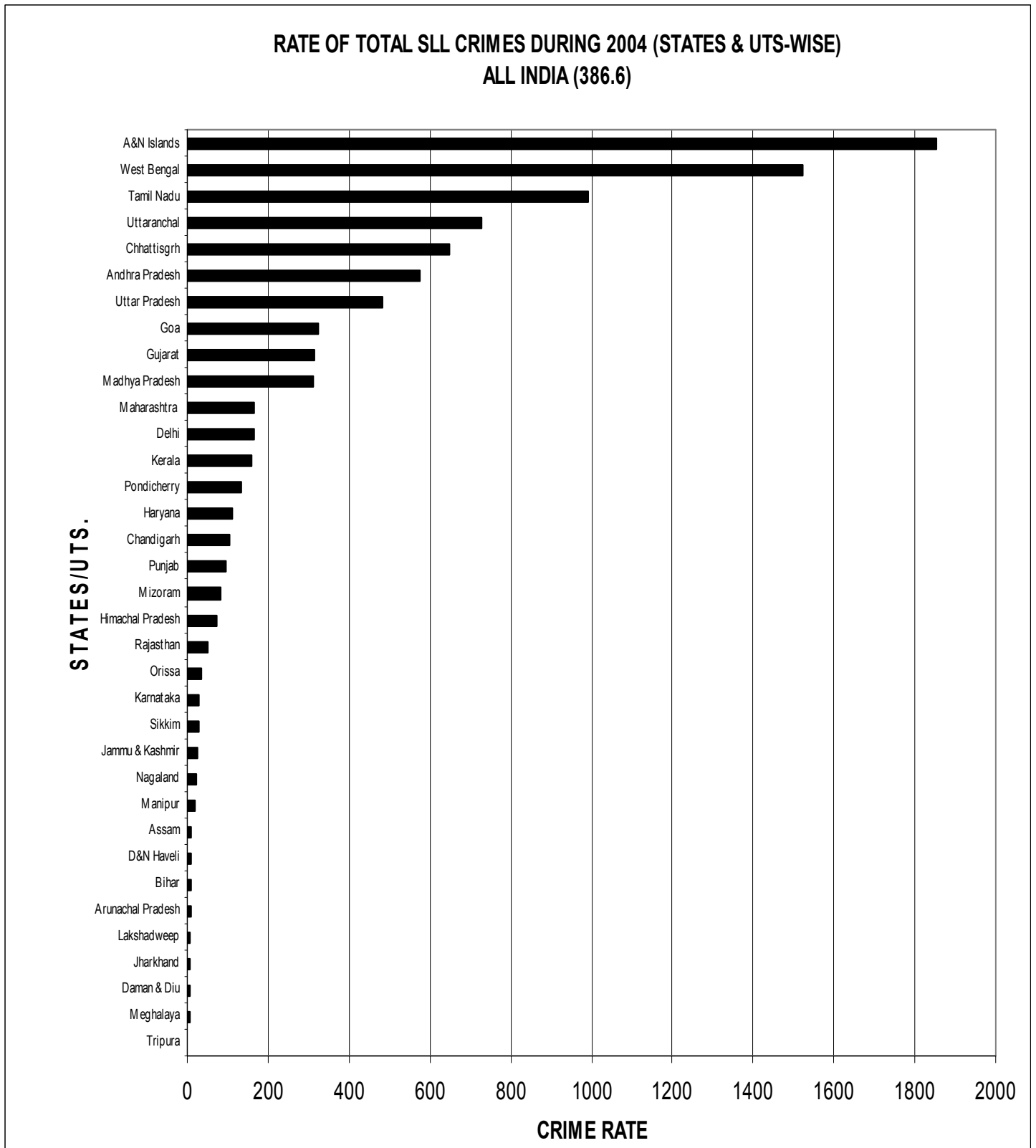

PERCENTAGE CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL SLL CRIMES DURING 2004

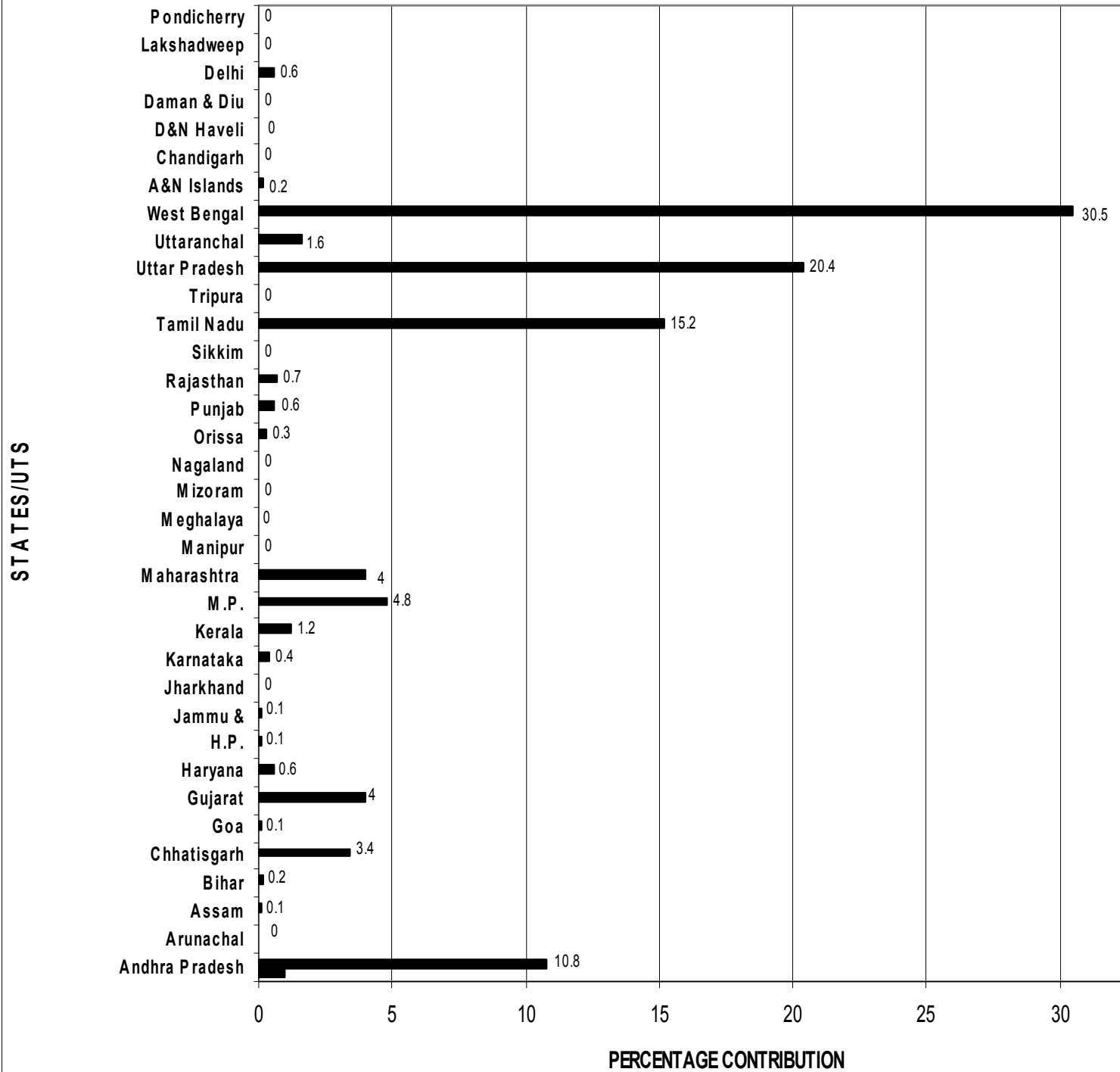
