Q1 : What is 'Data on Police Organisation' ?

Ans:

- ❖ It is BPR&D's Annual Publication since 1986.
- ❖ It has pan India Police Data Analysis (non crime data).
- ❖ Police strength, structure, recruitment, training, admin & logistics, budget, housing, communication etc. are key areas.

Q2 : What is this web application ?

Ans:

- ❖ The Web Application has been launched on 17/02/2017 to facilitate online data entry for 'Data on Police Organization'.
- ❖ Data for 2016 Publication is being obtained online.

Q3 : Who can access this application ?

Ans: Designated nodal officers of all States/UTs Police and CAPFs

Q4 : How to access this web application ?

Ans:

- ❖ There is link on BPR&D website for this application. (www.bprd.nic.in -> 'Online Data Entry System for 'Data on Police Organization')
- ❖ It can be accessed from any computer on NIC (National Informatics Centre) Network initially. After authentication of user by NIC, it can be accessed from any computer on Internet.

Q5 : How to get login/password ?

Ans: It has been provided to heads of all State/UT police and CAPF by BPR&D's confidential letter dated 17/2/2017.

Q6 : Can nodal officer be changed ?

Ans: Yes. But the change should be intimated to BPR&D by the concerned organization.

Q8 : What is the deadline for Data Entry by States/ UTs CAPFs ?

Ans: 15/3/2017

Q9: What is the deadline for Publication of ‘Data on Police Organization, 2016’ by BPR&D?

Ans: 31/3/2017

Q10: Whether to wait for next version for data entry ?

Ans:

- ❖ No. Data Entry should start forthwith in Ver 1.0 to meet the deadline of 15/3/2017.
- ❖ Ver 2.0 is under development and it will be introduced seamlessly without causing any hindrance to users.

Q11: What is the time period of data to be entered?

Ans:

- ❖ Data of only 2016 is to be entered as on 1/1/2017.
- ❖ Data of previous years (2015 and earlier) are not to be filled.
- ❖ Column for previous year’s data is for comparison only to ensure accuracy.

Q12 : What are the precautions for entering data?

Ans:

- ❖ **Kindly save data frequently to avoid loss of data in partially filled forms**
- ❖ **There is no NULL or NIL data. Use digit-0 instead of it. In case a particular data is not available immediately then use '0' for the time being to save the form. As the data becomes available, the form can be edited accordingly.**
- ❖ **Kindly compare from previous year's data to cross check major variation.**
- ❖ **Some figures should not normally decrease in subsequent year like 'sanctioned strength' housing units etc. Reasons may be given in remarks column, in case it is there.**
- ❖ **Posted strength should not be more than sanctioned strength in 'each rank' as well as overall figure.**
- ❖ **Kindly get the printout of filled in data and check thoroughly before final submission.**
- ❖ **Data once submitted cannot be resubmitted/edited again. Special permission from BPR&D can only enable resubmission.**

- ❖ **Help button for online assistance**
- ❖ **Details of user (nodal officer)**
- ❖ **2 users per organization- one for drafting & another for data approval**
