Press Release

Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, today released the **“Data on Police Organizations as on 1.1.2019”** in India, in the presence of Shri V S K Kaumudi, DG, BPR&D, and other senior officers of the BPR&D.

2. The BPR&D has been publishing the “Data on Police Organizations” annually since 1986. **“Data on Police Organizations as on 01/01/2018”** was released by Shri G. Kishan Reddy, MoS (Home) on the 24th of October, 2018. Simultaneously, the process for obtaining the data and preparation of **“DoPO as on 01.01.2019”** started and was completed by December, 2019.
