The Institute organizes a 03-days Workshop on Juvenile Justice & Human Rights. The basic topics covered by the course are Human Rights: Concept & Evolution; Observation of higher courts & relevant cases, laws on the issue of Human Rights violation; Overview of laws; Psychological, genetic, socio-economic & biological factors leading to juvenile delinquency; Child Trafficking; Precautions & procedures for dealing with suspects in lock-up; Police vis-à-vis Human Rights violation; Police & Juvenile Justice; role of inter-agency coordination in combating problems; Child Labor & Human Rights; Investigation of cases related to Juvenile Delinquency; Guidelines for dealing with vulnerable sections of society; Presentation of a case in Juvenile Justice Court etc. The trainees take part in Group Discussion and Training Films are shown on relevant topics.
