Preparation of Letter of Advice; Practical Exercise on Handling, Lifting, Packing, Labeling and forwarding of the evidences; RPF Act 1989, RPUP Act 1966 and Railways Act 1989; RPF and GRP and Local Police ó Co-operation and Co-ordination in their work; Visit to GRP and RPF Police Stations; Case Studies etc.
