From the DG's Desk

Among the functions of the BPR&D are capacity building and improving police service delivery by imparting knowledge and skills and inculcating the right attitude among the police personnel. BPR&D is making all out efforts through its in-house training facilities, besides sponsoring police officers and men to different Management Development Programmes, VICs, DSI courses and also by organizing workshops and conferences.

During this quarter, the BPR&D organized the 37th National Symposium of the Heads of Training Institutions, at the BPR&D Headquarters, New Delhi, on 12 - 13 December, 2019. The theme of the Symposium was "**Optimal Utilization of Resources - Through Sharing and Networking**". About 120 Heads of Police Training Institutions or their nominees attended the Symposium. The participants deliberated upon topics like 'Optimizing Capacity Building: Through Partnership and Collaboration', 'Understanding the Learners' Psychology', 'Skill Development: the Role of Coordination and Networking' and 'Optimal Utilization of Resources - through Sharing and Networking'. Further, the delegates were divided into three groups for Group Discussion and Presentation on topics like 'Police Training Policy', 'Trainer Development Programme' and 'Training Needs Analysis for the Indian Police'. For the purpose of assisting the Groups, expert consultants were also associated for value addition and shaping the discussions for meaningful outcomes. During the Symposium, the delegates were also exposed to the autonomous model of police training through topics like 'Autonomy in Governance - Maharashtra Police Academy' and 'State of the Art Training Infrastructure' highlighting the training facilities available with the CRPF Academy, Khadarpur, Gurugram, Haryana.
